Bruce Earle Fraser

July 4, 1938 - July 24, 2023



Bruce Earle Fraser of Penticton, beloved husband of Barbara Fraser, passed away peacefully after a lengthy illness on July 24, 2023 at the age of 85 years.

Bruce started his life in Gravenhurst, Ontario, oldest son of Earle and Margaret Fraser. He attended school there until he entered the Air Force at the age of 17. Bruce trained at Cold Lake, Alberta then was shipped out to Germany where he was driving the fuel trucks for the planes and acting as chauffeur to officers. On his return to Canada, he moved to Merritt, BC where he was employed with the ambulance, volunteer firemen, drove school bus, and worked as a tow truck driver. On his retirement, Bruce moved to Penticton where he resided until his passing.
